

Woodstream Corp. Warns of Potentially Hazardous Electric Fence Controllers

Date June 19, 2009: Woodstream Corp. is notifying regulatory agencies; other authorities having jurisdiction, and consumers that three Electric Fence Controllers manufactured by Woodstream Corp. may present a potential hazard.

Units: Up to 1000 Bird-B-Gone
Up to 250 Bird Shock

Manufacturer: Woodstream Corp.

Date of manufacture: May 2007 to December 2008 - Bird-B-Gone
December 2007 to March 2009 - Bird Shock

Identification: On the Label: The name "Bird-B-Gone" and a circle with a slash through a drawing of a bird, and the statements, "Electronic Bird Abatement for Birds and Small Animals". The Model designations found on the product as CHG-AC750 and CHG-ACSS5.

On the Label: The name "Bird Shock", with statement "Electric Bird Track Controller". It is further identified with "Bird Barrier America, Inc". The Model designation found on the product is SS-55 BB.

Hazard: When used in accordance with the product's marking, persons that may unexpectedly come into contact with the controller terminals, conductive wiring, or track energized by this controller could be subject to an electric shock. This unexpected shock could result in injury.

What you should do: Stop using the product immediately and return it the place of purchase.
